## ORDINANCE X

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CASCADE, LYCOMING COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF AN ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE COMMON-WEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVED JULY 31, 1968, NO.247, ARTICLE I, SEC. 101, ET SEQ., 53 PURDONS 10101, ET SEQ.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cascade as follows:

SECTION 1. A Planning Commission for Cascade Township is hereby established consisting of five members. All members of the Commission shall be residents of Cascade Township and shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Cascade Township.

SECTION 2. The term of each of the members of the Commission shall be for four (4) years, or until his successor is appointed and qualified, except that initially one member shall be appointed to serve for one (1) year, one for two (2) years, one for three (3) years and two for four (4) years.

SECTION 3. The Planning Commission and its members shall exercise all the powers and duties and shall be subject to all the provisions and requirements as contained in the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, approved July 31, 1968, Act No.247, Article I, Section 101, et seq., 53 P.S. 10101, et seq.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
